

Mass attendance Protocol review

Our volunteer ushers and greeters are donating their time to help us and we need to help them.

- If you arrive for Mass before the ushers and seat yourself, the ushers may ask you to move. Please cooperate.
- Ushers have instructions to seat people from the front of the church to the rear. Please DO NOT ask to sit somewhere else.
- Family units (people who live in the same household) can sit together in the same pew, however everyone else MUST adhere to social distancing guidelines.
- The ushers will dismiss people row by row when Mass is over. Please have patience and wait until it is your turn. DO NOT exit along the side aisles to visit with friends. DO NOT congregate in the rear of the church or outside on church property.
- Many of you have voiced concerns about singing during Mass. The rules have not changed! We are only allowed to have one Cantor as our voice and Michael is it. We still cannot have a choir. Please be respectful of your fellow parishioners and follow safety protocols by not singing!

Some of you have inquired about Christmas Masses. At this time Father Michael has made no decisions about additional Christmas Masses or the possibility of taking reservations for seating. We will keep you informed when these decisions are made.
